The purpose of the “TekEase” Program is to provide sustainable support of computer technology in schools in South Santa Barbara County. In doing so, a renewable cadre of technology proficient students will earn community service and learn job skills in the career pathway of technology.

TekEase participants will be contacted and asked to attend TekEase training workshops. Here participants will combine their already existing knowledge of computers with some hands-on training from computer industry professionals. This training will include both platforms (Macintosh and Window’s-based PC). With these skills, participants will be assigned to regular service at a local school in their region that is in need of computer technology support.
