



# Surveillance Testing Options

## OPTION A – Contract Direct

Contract direct with lab for processing and hire/train staff to conduct specimen collection. This is not an exhaustive list of labs, but these are labs Public Health has worked with for COVID testing.

### State run community testing - OptumServe

- By appointment only
- Appointments are made available a week in advance
- Availability varies
- Insurance information will be collected when you register, but no co-pay required. If you do not have insurance, the State of California will pay for your test. Please bring your identification, if you have one.
- Results typically returned within 2-7 days

## Option D – Public Health Expanded Testing

### Testing sites run by Public Health, County of Santa Barbara

- By appointment only, individual registration
- Appointments are made available a week in advance
- 2 hours are reserved for school staff each day of operation
- Medical coverage information requested - need to have insurance card available at check-in
- Priority: symptomatic staff or staff who are a confirmed contact with a positive case
- All sites operate Monday - Thursday
